ITEM NO. 3 - Reference Specifications, Special Conditions, Federal Wage Determination No. IN20210006, Modification No. 24, dated 10/29/2021, Pages 1 to 51:

DELETE: The Federal Wage Determination No. IN20210006, Modification No. 24, dated 10/29/2021 in its entirety.

REPLACE WITH: The Federal Wage Determination No. IN20210006, Modification No. 25, dated 11/12/2021 in its entirety.

ITEM NO. 4 - Reference Specifications, PROCESS EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS, M-14 New Production Wells No. 5 & 6, Page M-66:

DELETE: A well screen shall be nominal 20 inch diameter and approximately 40' long, made of stainless steel having openings running horizontal. The openings of the screen shall be determined after test well has been drilled and analysis made of sand and gravel formations in which screen will be located. The stainless steel well screen shall be equal to Johnson Mfg. Co. A stainless steel bottom plate shall be assembled with screen.

REPLACE WITH: A well screen shall be nominal 20 inch diameter and approximately 20' long, made of stainless steel having openings running horizontal. The openings of the screen shall be determined after test well has been drilled and analysis made of sand and gravel formations in which screen will be located. The stainless steel well screen shall be equal to Johnson Mfg. Co. A stainless steel bottom plate shall be assembled with screen.

ITEM NO. 5 - Reference Plans, Division II – New Water Supply Wells No. 5 and 6, Sheet 4:

CLARIFICATION: The stainless steel well screen shall be 20" instead of 18" in diameter.
